The best internet has been installed at The Farm at Cane Creek! Skyrunner, Inc., a regional Internet service provider, has begun installing homes with faster, more dependable Internet service within The Farm at Cane Creek. Our teams have been working diligently to install fiber optic cable infrastructure throughout the community. Service will be available to homeowners at the following rates:

- \$75/mo Fiber 250 speeds up to 125x125 Mbps, 250GB/mo, overages are 50¢ per GB
- \$99/mo Fiber 500 speeds up to 125x125 Mbps, 500GB/mo, overage are 50¢ per GB
- \$115/mo Fiber Unlimited speeds up to 125x125 Mbps, unlimited usage

There will be a one-time installation fee of \$150 for your Internet connection. Installation includes running a fiber optic cable to your home, installing a small outdoor enclosure on the back of your home, and providing an Ethernet connection to a better Internet experience (included in the installation cost). Once your service is installed, you will need to decide on how you want your internal home network setup. Most homes today want WIFI service for computers, TVs, tablets, and phones available throughout the house. For an additional cost, Skyrunner can provide home networking services, including running Ethernet network cable in your house, installing wireless access points for WIFI coverage, and helping you configure your devices to connect to the Internet. Skyrunner will provide a price list of home networking options upon request. Of course, you can purchase your own wireless router and set it up yourself, or you can hire one of the many regional home networking and automation providers in the area to assist you.
